CONFERENCE COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to state legislative entities; making an appropriation to the Oklahoma House of Representatives; stating purposes; reappropriating funds to the Oklahoma House of Representatives for renovations; making reappropriation nonfiscal; making appropriations to the Legislative Service Bureau; stating purpose; appropriating certain monies to the Legislative Service Bureau for the Oklahoma Criminal Justice Resource Center; amending Section 128 of Enrolled House Bill No. 3050 of the 2nd Session of the 46th Oklahoma Legislature, which relates to appropriations to the Department of Public Safety; modifying appropriation amount; amending 57 O.S. 1991, Section 508.2, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 254, O.S.L. 1997 (57 O.S. Supp. 1997, Section 508.2), which relates to the Oklahoma Criminal Justice Resource Center; transferring the Center to the Legislative Service Bureau; making appropriations to the Oklahoma State Senate; stating purpose; making appropriations nonfiscal; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

OKLAHOMA HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma House of Representatives from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1999, the amount of Four Hundred Seventy-one Thousand Two Hundred Forty-five Dollars (\$471,245.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to pay the salaries, per diem, and expenses of the members of the Oklahoma House of Representatives,

the salaries of the employees of the Oklahoma House of Representatives, and other necessary expenses. Claims and payrolls filed against the appropriation made to the Oklahoma House of Representatives for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1999, shall be approved by the Speaker of the House of Representatives.

SECTION 2. REAPPROPRIATION The amount of One Million Two Hundred Twenty-four Thousand Six Hundred Sixty-three Dollars (\$1,224,663.00) of the amount of One Million Four Hundred Eighty-six Thousand Six Hundred Seventy-nine Dollars (\$1,486,679.00), originally appropriated to the Legislative Service Bureau by Section 6, Chapter 268, O.S.L. 1995, from any monies in the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996, not otherwise appropriated, for renovation of the space allotted to the Oklahoma House of Representatives by Section 15.2 of Title 73 of the Oklahoma Statutes, as reappropriated and redesignated to the Oklahoma House of Representatives by Section 25, Chapter 328, O.S.L. 1996, for the renovation of space under the control of the Oklahoma House of Representatives, is hereby reappropriated to the Oklahoma House of Representatives for the renovation of space under the control of the Oklahoma House of Representatives. The reappropriation made by this section shall not be subject to fiscal year limitations and shall be available for encumbrance and expenditure purposes for a period of thirty (30) months from the date this act is approved.

LEGISLATIVE SERVICE BUREAU

SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated to the Legislative Service Bureau from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1999, the sum of Nineteen Thousand Two Hundred Thirty Dollars (\$19,230.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Legislative Service Bureau by law.

SECTION 4. There is hereby appropriated to the Legislative Service Bureau from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year

ending June 30, 1999, the sum of Six Hundred Five Thousand Eight Hundred Ninety-four Dollars (\$605,894.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to fund the operations of the Oklahoma Criminal Justice Resource Center.

SECTION 5. AMENDATORY Section 128 of Enrolled House Bill No. 3050 of the 2nd Session of the 46th Oklahoma Legislature, is amended to read as follows:

Section 128. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Public Safety from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1999, the sum of ~~Fifty-two Million Five Hundred Twenty-two Thousand One Hundred Forty-four Dollars (\$52,522,144.00)~~ Fifty-two Million Five Thousand Six Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$52,005,650.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Department of Public Safety by law.

SECTION 6. AMENDATORY 57 O.S. 1991, Section 508.2, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 254, O.S.L. 1997 (57 O.S. Supp. 1997, Section 508.2), is amended to read as follows:

Section 508.2 A. ~~There~~ Effective July 1, 1998, there is hereby ~~created~~ transferred from the Department of Public Safety to the Legislative Service Bureau the Oklahoma Criminal Justice Resource Center which shall consist of the entity recognized by the Bureau of Justice Statistics as the Statistical Analysis Center, a prevention and intervention unit, a resource development unit, and an administrative support unit. ~~Effective July 1, 1997, the Criminal Justice Resource Center is hereby transferred to the Department of Public Safety.~~

B. Effective July 1, ~~1997~~ 1998, all unexpended funds, property, records, personnel, and outstanding financial obligations and encumbrances of the Oklahoma Criminal Justice Resource Center are hereby transferred to the ~~Department of Public Safety~~ Legislative Service Bureau. All transferred personnel shall retain their employment position and status as unclassified or classified employees. The Director of State Finance is hereby directed to coordinate the transfer of funds, allotments, purchase Req. No. 3269Page 3

orders, and outstanding financial obligations, or encumbrances, provided for by the provisions of this subsection.

C. The duties of the Oklahoma Criminal Justice Resource Center shall be to:

1. Provide a clearinghouse for criminal justice information;
2. Provide a central contact point for federal, state, and local criminal justice agencies;
3. Provide technical assistance for all criminal justice agencies of this state;
4. Provide consultation for criminal justice agencies of this state in preparing reports, gaining funding, or preparing information;
5. Obtain information from criminal justice agencies in this state for analyses of criminal justice issues;
6. Collect and analyze criminal justice data;
7. Produce reports for state and local criminal justice agencies;
8. Facilitate information networking between criminal justice agencies;
9. Attend meetings concerning criminal justice issues;
10. Represent this state at national meetings including, but not limited to, meetings or conferences of criminal justice statistics associations of other states;
11. Provide administrative support to the Oklahoma Sentencing Commission;
12. Assist in developing resources for the criminal justice system;
13. Address pertinent issues related to prevention and intervention programs;
14. Provide assistance to the State Crime Stoppers Association; and
15. Maintain support and provide assistance to the Oklahoma Council on Violence Prevention.

D. The ~~Department of Public Safety~~ Legislative Service Bureau shall provide office space, equipment, and other administrative support required by the Oklahoma Criminal Justice Resource Center.

E. The Oklahoma Criminal Justice Resource Center shall have a director and other necessary staff. The Oklahoma Sentencing Commission shall hire and set the salaries of the director and any other staff of the Oklahoma Criminal Justice Resource Center, subject to appropriation.

OKLAHOMA STATE SENATE

SECTION 7. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma State Senate from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1999, the sum of Three Hundred Twenty-one Thousand Nine Hundred Twenty-six Dollars (\$321,926.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the State Senate by law.

SECTION 8. The appropriations made by this act shall not be subject to fiscal year limitations and shall be available for encumbrance and expenditure purposes for a period of thirty (30) months from the date this act is approved.

SECTION 9. This act shall become effective July 1, 1998.

SECTION 10. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
