COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to counties; amending 19 O.S. 1991, Section 180.62, as amended by Section 8, Chapter 239, O.S.L. 1993, 19 O.S. 1991, Section 180.64A, as amended by Section 10, Chapter 239, O.S.L. 1993, Section 6, Chapter 334, O.S.L. 1993, and Section 10, Chapter 334, O.S.L. 1993, (19 O.S. Supp. 1997, Sections 180.62, 180.64A, 180.74, and 180.78), which relates to county officer basic salaries and minimum salaries; providing basic salary increases; establishing increase to minimum salaries; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 19 O.S. 1991, Section 180.62, as amended by Section 8, Chapter 239, O.S.L. 1993 (19 O.S. Supp. 1997, Section 180.62), is amended to read as follows:

Section 180.62 A. The basic salaries of county officers upon which all salaries and future increases or decreases thereof shall be computed, shall be as follows:

1. In every county having a net valuation of all tangible taxable property, as defined in Sections 180.58 and 180.59 of this

title, of Forty Million Dollars (\$40,000,000.00) or less, the basic salary of each of the county officers named in paragraph 1 of Section 180.61 of this title shall not ~~exceed~~ be less than Nineteen Thousand Dollars (\$19,000.00) per annum nor shall it exceed Thirty-nine Thousand Dollars (\$39,000.00) per annum;

2. In every county having a net valuation of all tangible taxable property, as defined in Sections 180.58 and 180.59 of this title, of more than Forty Million Dollars (\$40,000,000.00) but not more than Eighty Million Dollars (\$80,000,000.00), the basic salary of each of the county officers named in paragraph 1 of Section 180.61 of this title shall not ~~exceed~~ be less than Twenty-two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$22,500.00) per annum nor shall it exceed Forty-two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$42,500.00) per annum;

3. In every county having a net valuation of all tangible taxable property, as defined in Sections 180.58 and 180.59 of this title, of more than Eighty Million Dollars (\$80,000,000.00) but not more than Three Hundred Million Dollars (\$300,000,000.00), the basic salary of each of the county officers named in paragraph 1 of Section 180.61 of this title shall not ~~exceed~~ be less than Twenty-four Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$24,500.00) per annum nor shall it exceed Forty-four Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$44,500.00) per annum;

4. In every county having a net valuation of all tangible taxable property, as defined in Sections 180.58 and 180.59 of this title, of more than Three Hundred Million Dollars (\$300,000,000.00) but not more than Six Hundred Million Dollars (\$600,000,000.00), the basic salary of each of the county officers named in paragraph 1 of Section 180.61 of this title shall not ~~exceed~~ be less than Twenty-two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$22,500.00) per annum nor shall it exceed Forty-two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$42,500.00) per annum; and

5. In every county having a net valuation of all tangible taxable property, as defined in Sections 180.58 and 180.59 of this title, of more than Six Hundred Million Dollars (\$600,000,000.00), the basic salary of each of the county officers named in paragraph 1 of Section 180.61 of this title shall not ~~exceed~~ be less than Nineteen Thousand Dollars (\$19,000.00) per annum nor shall it exceed Thirty-nine Thousand Dollars (\$39,000.00) per annum.

B. In all counties of this state, the total annual salaries of each of the county officers named in paragraph 2 of Section 180.61 of this title shall be fixed by the board of county commissioners except where otherwise provided by law, and in each county the salary last fixed by the board of county commissioners before the election or appointment of any such officer shall be the applicable salary for such county officer for the ensuing term.

C. The annual salaries fixed by this act shall be paid either monthly or twice a month, by order of the board of county commissioners, for each month or fraction thereof the incumbent lawfully occupies and holds title to such office.

SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 19 O.S. 1991, Section 180.64A, as amended by Section 10, Chapter 239, O.S.L. 1993 (19 O.S. Supp. 1997, Section 180.64A), is amended to read as follows:

Section 180.64A A. In every county having a net valuation of all tangible taxable property as defined in Sections 180.58 and 180.59 of this title, of Ten Million Dollars (\$10,000,000.00) or less, the minimum salary of the sheriff and for all other officers named in paragraph 1 of Section 180.61 of this title shall be ~~Eleven Thousand Three Hundred Forty-five Dollars (\$11,345.00) per annum, payable monthly~~ the basic salary set forth in Section 180.62 hereof.

B. In every county having a net valuation of all tangible taxable property as defined in Sections 180.58 and 180.59 of this title, of more than Ten Million Dollars (\$10,000,000.00), the minimum salary for the sheriff and the minimum salary for all other

officers named in paragraph 1 of Section 180.61 of this title shall be ~~Twelve Thousand One Hundred Ninety Dollars (\$12,190.00) per annum, payable monthly~~ the basic salary set forth in Section 180.62 hereof.

SECTION 3. AMENDATORY Section 6, Chapter 334, O.S.L. 1993, (19 O.S. Supp. 1997, Section 180.74), is amended to read as follows:

Section 180.74 A. The basic salaries of county officers upon which all salaries and future increases or decreases thereof shall be computed, shall be as follows:

1. In every county having a service-ability factor, as defined in Section ~~3 of this act~~ 180.71 of this title of Four Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$400,000.00) or less, the basic salary of each of the county officers named in ~~paragraph 1 of Section 5 of this act~~ 180.73 of this title shall not ~~exceed~~ be less than Nineteen Thousand Dollars (\$19,000.00) per annum nor shall it exceed Thirty-nine Thousand Dollars (\$39,000.00) per annum;

2. In every county having a service-ability factor, as defined in Section ~~3 of this act~~ 180.71 of this title, of more than Four Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$400,000.00) but not more than Eight Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$800,000.00), the basic salary of each of the county officers named in paragraph 1 of Section ~~5 of this act~~ 180.73 of this title shall not ~~exceed~~ be less than Twenty-two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$22,500.00) per annum nor shall it exceed Forty-two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$42,500.00) per annum;

3. In every county having a service-ability factor, as defined in Section ~~3 of this act~~ 180.71 of this title, of more than Eight Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$800,000.00) but not more than Three Million Dollars (\$3,000,000.00), the basic salary of each of the county officers named in paragraph 1 of Section ~~5 of this act~~ 180.73 of this title shall not ~~exceed~~ be less than Twenty-four Thousand

Five Hundred Dollars (\$24,500.00) per annum nor shall it exceed Forty-four Thousand Five Hundred Dollars \$44,500.00) per annum;

4. In every county having a service-ability factor, as defined in Section ~~3 of this act~~ 180.71 of this title, of more than Three Million Dollars (\$3,000,000.00) but not more than Six Million Dollars (\$6,000,000.00), the basic salary of each of the county officers named in paragraph 1 of Section ~~5 of this act~~ 180.73 of this title shall not ~~exceed~~ be less than Twenty-two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$22,500.00) per annum nor shall it exceed Forty-two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars \$42,500.00) per annum; and

5. In every county having a service-ability factor, as defined in Section ~~3 of this act~~ 180.71 of this title, of more than Six Million Dollars (\$6,000,000.00), the basic salary of each of the county officers named in paragraph 1 of Section ~~5 of this act~~ 180.73 of this title shall not ~~exceed~~ be less than Nineteen Thousand Dollars (\$19,000.00) per annum nor shall it exceed Thirty-nine Thousand Dollars \$39,000.00) per annum.

B. In all counties of this state, the total annual salaries of each of the county officers named in paragraph 2 of Section ~~5 of this act~~ 180.73 of this title shall be fixed by the board of county commissioners except where otherwise provided by law, and in each county the salary last fixed by the board of county commissioners before the election or appointment of any such officer shall be the applicable salary for such county officer for the ensuing term.

C. The annual salaries fixed by this act shall be paid either monthly or twice a month, by order of the board of county commissioners, for each month or fraction thereof the incumbent lawfully occupies and holds title to such office.

SECTION 4. AMENDATORY Section 10, Chapter 334, O.S.L. 1993, (19 O.S. Supp. 1997, Section 180.78), is amended to read as follows:

Section 180.78 A. In every county having a service-ability factor, as defined in Section ~~3 of this act~~ 180.71 of this title, of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) or less, the minimum salary of the sheriff and for all other officers referred to in paragraph 1 of Section ~~5 of this act~~ 180.73 of this title shall be ~~Eleven Thousand Three Hundred Forty-five Dollars (\$11,345.00) per annum, payable monthly~~ the basic salary set forth in Section 180.74 hereof.

B. In every county having a service-ability factor, as defined in Section ~~3 of this act~~ 180.71 of this title, of more than One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00), the minimum salary for the sheriff and the minimum salary for all other officers referred to in paragraph 1 of Section ~~5 of this act~~ 180.73 of this title shall be ~~Twelve Thousand One Hundred Ninety Dollars (\$12,190.00) per annum, payable monthly~~ the basic salary set forth in Section 180.74 hereof.

SECTION 5. This act shall become effective November 1, 1998.
