COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to public buildings and public works;
prohibiting awarding contract to bidder unless bid
lists subcontractors; requiring certain approval
for change in subcontractors; providing for
codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 120.1 of Title 61, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

No public construction contract shall be awarded to a bidder
unless the bid lists each subcontractor who will perform services
under the contract. No successful bidder shall change any
subcontractor without written consent of the governing body of the
awarding public agency, evidenced by resolution.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
