COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to roads, bridges and ferries;

designating the Korean War Veterans Highway;

requiring the Department of Transportation to place

and maintain certain markers on certain highway;

providing for codification; and declaring an

emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1628 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Interstate Highway 40 westbound from the Interstate Highway 35 and Interstate Highway 40 intersection to the state line shall be designated as the "Korean War Veterans Highway". Such name shall serve as an expression of the appreciation of the entire State of Oklahoma and to memorialize the men and women who served in the War. The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent

markers to be placed and maintained on the highway bearing such name.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
