casualty agents - repealing 85 O.S., Section 113 -
codification - emergency)

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 65.5 of Title 85, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Any insurer approved to offer workers' compensation equivalent
insurance pursuant to the provisions of Section 65 of Title 85 of
the Oklahoma Statutes may appoint property and casualty agents. All
agents appointed for workers' compensation equivalent insurance
products must be licensed as property and casualty agents by the
Oklahoma Insurance Department.

SECTION 2. REPEALER Section 38, Chapter 1, Second
Extraordinary Session, O.S.L. 1994 (85 O.S. Supp. 1996, Section
113), is hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
