

ENGROSSED HOUSE

An Act relating to the Militia; providing certain rights to members of the Oklahoma National Guard while serving on active duty; specifying such rights; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 208.1 of Title 44, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The following provisions of federal law shall be adopted as state law and applied to members of the Oklahoma National Guard when such members are ordered to state active duty under Sections 501 through 507 of Title 32 of the United States Code:

1. The Soldiers' and Sailors' Civil Relief Act of 1940, as amended, Sections 501 through 593 of Title 50 of the United States Code App. (1988 and 1994); and

2. The Uniformed Services Employment and Reemployment Rights Act (USERRA), Sections 4301 through 4333 of Title 38 of the United States Code.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby

declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
