

ENGROSSED HOUSE  
BILL NO. 1370

An Act relating to public health and safety;  
providing for inspection by peace officers of  
vessels, motors, trailers, and related equipment  
while in public garage or repair shop under certain  
circumstances; providing for codification; and  
providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 4209.8 of Title 63, unless there  
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Any peace officer of the State of Oklahoma may inspect any  
vessel, motor, trailer, or related equipment in any public garage or  
repair shop or in any place where such vessel, motor, trailer or  
related equipment is being held for sale or wrecking, for the  
purpose of locating stolen vessels, motors, trailers, or related  
equipment and investigating the title and registration of those  
items.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1997.
