An Act relating to public health and safety;
requiring certain housing authorities to provide
certain separate buildings for elderly residents;
providing for codification; and providing an
effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1062.1 of Title 63, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Any housing authority subject to the Oklahoma Housing
Authorities Act, operating a senior citizens center, housing
project, or other facility in which elderly persons, aged sixty-five
(65) or older, may be housed and in which persons between the ages
of nineteen (19) and forty (40) also reside or are housed shall
provide separate buildings for such elderly tenants. The separate
buildings shall provide elderly tenants at such facility, separate
spatial areas at which dining, sleeping, recreational and general
living activities shall be provided without any haphazard or

accidental contact with tenants between the ages of nineteen (19) and forty (40) at such facility.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1997.
