

ENGROSSED HOUSE

An Act relating to the Pardon and Parole Board;
requiring members of the Board to receive certain
training; providing for provision of training by
staff of the Board; providing for codification; and
providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 332.1A of Title 57, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Each member of the Pardon and Parole Board shall receive at
least sixteen (16) hours of training for the first year and eight
(8) hours of training per year thereafter on matters relating to the
duties of the Board. The training shall be provided by personnel of
the Pardon and Parole Board according to guidelines adopted by the
Board.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1997.
