BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

ATTORNEY GENERAL

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of the Attorney General from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1998, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Attorney General by law.

DISTRICT ATTORNEYS COUNCIL

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of the Attorney General from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1998, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the District Attorneys and District Attorneys Council by law.

INDIGENT DEFENSE SYSTEM

SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Indigent Defense System from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1998, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Indigent Defense System by law.

SECTION 4. The appropriations made by Sections 1, 2 and 3 of this act shall be subject to fiscal year limitations and may be encumbered through June 30, 1998. Any unexpended funds remaining after November 15, 1998, shall lapse and be transferred to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.

SECTION 5. This act shall become effective July 1, 1997.

SECTION 6. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
