BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

STATE BANKING DEPARTMENT

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the State Banking Department from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1998, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the State Banking Department by law.

COMMISSION ON CONSUMER CREDIT

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the Commission on Consumer Credit from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1998, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Commission on Consumer Credit by law.

OKLAHOMA SECURITIES COMMISSION

SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Securities Commission from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal

year ending June 30, 1998, the sum of ____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Securities Commission by law.

SECTION 4. The appropriations made by Sections 1, 2 and 3 of this act shall be subject to fiscal year limitations and may be encumbered through June 30, 1998. Any unexpended funds remaining after November 15, 1998, shall lapse and be transferred to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.

SECTION 5. This act shall become effective July 1, 1997.

SECTION 6. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
