BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 1998, the State
Board of Vocational and Technical Education shall budget all funds
in the following categories:

SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the State Department of Vocational and Technical Education by law shall be set by the Board. The salary of the Director of the State Department of Vocational and Technical Education shall not exceed Eighty-three Thousand Eight Hundred sixty-two Dollars (\$83,862.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1998. The State Department of Vocational and Technical Education for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1998, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 1997.
