

ENGROSSED HOUSE

An Act relating to public finance; prohibiting expenditure of certain funds for certain purpose; prohibiting expenditures for certain item; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 97 of Title 62, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

No funds made available to any state agency, board, commission, department or other entity of state government or funds made available to any local governmental agency or entity through any state agency, board, commission, department or other entity of state government shall be expended for the purpose of providing condoms for the prevention of human acquired immune deficiency syndrome.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1997.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
