An Act relating to state government; amending 74 O.S.  
1991, Section 4109, which relates to restoration  
and preservation projects of the State Capitol  
Building; adding certain projects on the Governor's  
Mansion to competitive bidding exemption; and  
providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 1991, Section 4109, is  
amended to read as follows:

Section 4109. By the order of the Director of ~~Public Affairs~~  
the Department of Central Services, restoration and preservation  
projects of the State Capitol Building or of the Governor's Mansion  
may be exempted from the provisions of the Public Competitive  
Bidding Act, Section 101 et seq. of Title 61 of the Oklahoma  
Statutes. For exempted State Capitol Building or Governor's Mansion  
construction projects, the ~~Office of Public Affairs~~ Department of  
Central Services shall select among contractors qualified by past  
experience to conduct historical preservation projects.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1997.
