

ENGROSSED HOUSE

An Act relating to counties and county officers;
authorizing county treasurer or county clerk to
charge fee to certain entities receiving tax
revenues; requiring county treasurer or county
clerk to prepare certain estimate; requiring
estimate to be itemized and filed with county
excise board or county budget board; requiring
statement to be sent to tax recipients; providing
for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 153.1 of Title 19, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The county treasurer or county clerk may charge a fee to any
entity which is the recipient of revenue from a designated county
sales tax levied for that entity as reimbursement for the cost of
collecting, maintaining, and distributing the funds on behalf of the
entity.

B. The county treasurer or county clerk shall prepare a special
estimate of needs each fiscal year covering all expenditures of the

office on behalf of the entities receiving the sales tax revenue. The estimate of need shall be itemized by personal services, maintenance, and operation expenditures for each taxing entity and filed with the county excise board or county budget board.

C. In reviewing and approving the estimate as provided in subsection B of this section, the county excise board or county budget board shall charge such costs among the various recipients receiving the revenue and shall render a statement to each entity for reimbursement to the county general fund.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1998.
