BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. Effective July 1, 1998, all communications personnel and all commissioned officers of the Department of Public Safety, correctional and probation and parole officers of the Department of Corrections, commissioned officers of the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation, commissioned officers of the Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control, commissioned officers of the Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement Commission and all commissioned officers employed by the state university hospitals, Oklahoma Horse Racing Commission, forestry division of the State Department of Agriculture, Liquefied Petroleum Gas Board, State Department of Tourism and Recreation, Conservation Division of the Oklahoma Corporation Commission, Department of Human Services, Military Department of the State of Oklahoma, Board of Pharmacy, State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision, the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training and the State Fire Marshal shall be awarded

an annualized increase of _____, exclusive of longevity pay or shift differential pay.

SECTION 2. NONCODIFICATION The provisions of Section 1 of this act shall not be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 1998.

SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
