

ENGROSSED HOUSE

An Act relating to counties and county officers;  
amending 19 O.S. 1991, Section 165, as amended by  
Section 6, Chapter 239, O.S.L. 1993 (19 O.S. Supp.  
1997, Section 165), which relates to travel  
allowance for county officers; modifying travel  
allowance for county sheriffs; and providing an  
effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 19 O.S. 1991, Section 165, as  
amended by Section 6, Chapter 239, O.S.L. 1993 (19 O.S. Supp. 1997,  
Section 165), is amended to read as follows:

Section 165. In lieu of reimbursement for traveling expenses  
within their county each county commissioner ~~and sheriff~~ may receive  
a monthly travel allowance of Three Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$350.00)  
and each sheriff may receive a monthly travel allowance of Five  
Hundred Dollars (\$500.00). In lieu of the reimbursement for  
traveling expenses authorized by law for each county officer, each  
county assessor may receive a monthly travel allowance of Two  
Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00), and each county clerk, court clerk  
and county treasurer may receive a monthly travel allowance of One  
Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$150.00). Each such county officer may be

subject to the penalty provided by Section 166 of this title for failure to attend the meetings specified in that section.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1998.
