(Oklahoma Commission on Children and Youth - duties and
compensation of employees - effective date)

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Commission on Children and Youth by law shall be set by the Director. The salary of the Director shall not exceed Forty-seven Thousand Four Hundred Twenty-eight Dollars (\$47,428.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1999. The Oklahoma Commission on Children and Youth, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1999, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
