WHEREAS, the "Say No to Hate" Coalition works to expose violations of human rights and protects the rights, safety and fundamental freedoms of all human beings; and

WHEREAS, the "Say No to Hate" Coalition works to achieve these objectives for the improvement of the quality of life in the State of Oklahoma.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 46TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the Oklahoma Legislature depllores acts of hatred based on bias, bigotry, and prejudice in all its forms.

THAT the Oklahoma Legislature supports and applauds the "Say No to Hate" Coalition in all its efforts to protect the fundamental rights and freedoms of human beings.

THAT the Oklahoma Legislature proclaims the month of February, 1997, as Brotherhood/Sisterhood Month in the State of Oklahoma.

THAT a copy of this resolution be distributed to the "Say No to Hate" Coalition of Central Oklahoma.
