A Concurrent Resolution relating to rules of the Corporation Commission; waiving the thirty-legislative-day review period for proposed amendments to permanent rules OAC 165:10-17-11, OAC 165:10-21-22, OAC 165:10-21-36, OAC 165:10-21-45, OAC 165:10-21-55, OAC 165:10-21-56, OAC 165:10-21-66, OAC 165:10-21-78 and proposed revocation of permanent rule OAC 165:10-21-46, which relate to oil and gas conservation; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 308 of Title 75 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the Legislature may waive the thirty-legislative-day review period for any rule which has been transmitted for legislative review; and

WHEREAS, on February 23, 1998, the Corporation Commission submitted to the Legislature for its review proposed amendments to permanent rules OAC 165:10-17-11, OAC 165:10-21-22, OAC 165:10-21-36, OAC 165:10-21-45, OAC 165:10-21-55, OAC 165:10-21-56, OAC 165:10-21-66, OAC 165:10-21-78 and proposed revocation of permanent rule OAC 165:10-21-46, relating to oil and gas conservation, regarding gas well operations and permitted production and applications for tax exemptions; and

WHEREAS, the Legislature recognizes the substantive value and importance of such proposed revocation and amendments to the permanent rules.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 46TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the Legislature hereby waives the thirty-legislative-day review period of the proposed amendments to permanent rules OAC 165:10-17-11, OAC 165:10-21-22, OAC 165:10-21-36, OAC 165:10-21-45, OAC 165:10-21-55, OAC 165:10-21-56, OAC 165:10-21-66, OAC 165:10-21-78 and proposed revocation of permanent rule OAC 165:10-21-46.

THAT copies of this resolution shall be distributed to the Governor, the Corporation Commissioners and the Editor of "The Oklahoma Register".
