An Act relating to state government; prohibiting the State and Education Employees Group Insurance Board from making certain adjustments; providing for noncodification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the State and Education Employees Group Insurance Board shall not make a mid-year adjustment in the premium rates for the Insurance plans offered by the Board for the FY-98 plan year, unless specially authorized to do so by the Legislature.

SECTION 2. NONCODIFICATION Section 1 of this act shall not be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
