An Act relating to aircraft and airports; amending 3 O.S. 1991, Section 65.13, which relates to federal and state aid for municipalities; deleting certain authority for Oklahoma Aeronautics Commission to act as agent for municipalities; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 3 O.S. 1991, Section 65.13, is amended to read as follows:

Section 65.13 ~~(a)~~ Acceptance Authorized, Conditions. Every municipality is authorized to accept, receive, receipt for, disburse and expend federal and state monies and other monies, public or private, made available by grant or loan or both to accomplish, in whole or in part, any of the purposes of this act. All federal monies accepted under this section shall be accepted and expended by the municipality upon such terms and conditions as are prescribed by the United States and as are consistent with state law; and all state monies accepted under this section shall be accepted and expended by the municipality upon such terms and conditions as are prescribed by the state. Unless otherwise prescribed by the agency from which such monies were received, the chief financial officer of the municipality shall, on its behalf deposit all monies received pursuant to this section and shall keep them, in separate funds designated according to the purposes for which the monies were made available, in trust for such purposes.

~~(b) Aeronautics Commission as Agent. A municipality is authorized to designate the Oklahoma Aviation Commission as its agent to accept, receive, receipt for and disburse federal and state monies, and other monies, public or private made available by grant or loan or both to accomplish, in whole or in part, any of the purposes of this act; and to designate the said Commission as its agent in contracting for and supervising the planning, acquisition, development, construction, improvement, maintenance, equipment or operation of any airport or other air navigation facility. All contracts made, let or awarded by said Commission acting as agent of a municipality under authority of this section, shall be made, let or awarded pursuant to the laws governing the making of contracts by or on behalf of the state. Such municipality may enter into an agreement with said Commission prescribing the terms and conditions of the agency in accordance with such terms and conditions as are prescribed by the United States, if federal money is involved, and in accordance with the applicable laws of this state. All federal monies accepted under this section by said Commission shall be accepted and transferred or expended by said Commission upon such~~

~~terms and conditions as are prescribed by the United States. All monies received by said Commission pursuant to this subsection shall be deposited in the State Treasury, and unless otherwise prescribed by the agency from which such monies were received, shall be kept in separate funds designated according to the purposes for which the monies were made available, and held by the state in trust for such purposes.~~

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1997.
