An Act relating to property; specifying
circumstances which shall constitute a public
nuisance; providing for codification; and providing
an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 21 of Title 50, unless there is
created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The repeated use of any real property or structure thereon to
commit a felony violation of the Oklahoma Uniform Controlled
Dangerous Substances Act may constitute a public nuisance.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1998.
