An Act relating to motor vehicles; amending 47 O.S. 1991, Section 108.1, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 142, O.S.L. 1996 (47 O.S. Supp. 1996, Section 108.1), which relates to jurisdiction of cities and towns to regulate traffic on boundary lines; removing requirement for execution of certain agreements for enforcement of traffic ordinances on streets forming boundary lines; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 1991, Section 108.1, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 142, O.S.L. 1996 (47 O.S. Supp. 1996, Section 108.1), is amended to read as follows:

Section 108.1 Any city or town may promulgate, adopt and enforce ordinances governing and regulating the operation of motor vehicles and other traffic upon roads, streets and highways that form the boundary line of such city or town, subject to the provisions of Section 15-101 et seq. of this title, ~~if the city or town enforcing the ordinances has executed an interlocal agreement, pursuant to the Interlocal Cooperation Act, with the adjoining jurisdiction.~~

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1997.
