An Act relating to the Commission on Consumer Credit; amending 59 O.S. 1991, Section 2011, which relates to the Health Spa Revolving Fund; modifying authorized expenditures from the fund; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 1991, Section 2011, is amended to read as follows:

Section 2011. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund for the ~~Department of~~ Commission on Consumer Credit to be designated the "Health Spa Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of registration and annual renewal fees provided for in Section 2002 of Title 59 of the Oklahoma Statutes. All monies accruing to the credit of said fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Department of Consumer Credit for the operating expenses of the Department and for the administration of the Oklahoma Health Spa Act. Expenditures from said fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of State Finance for approval and payment.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective September 1, 1997.
