An Act relating to motor vehicles; creating the Joint Legislative Committee on the Motor Carrier Enforcement System; stating purpose; providing for appointments; providing for staffing; providing for compensation; providing for noncodification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. A. There is hereby created to continue until February 1, 1998, the Joint Legislative Committee on the Motor Carrier Enforcement System. The purpose of the Committee shall be to review the current state laws and the system of motor carrier enforcement and assess the feasibility of consolidating all motor carrier enforcement authority under one state agency or entity, and to make recommendations for legislative action.

B. The Committee shall be composed of three members of the Oklahoma House of Representatives, to be appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives, and three members of the Oklahoma State Senate, to be appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate.

C. Staffing for the Committee shall be provided by the staffs of the Oklahoma House of Representatives and the Oklahoma State Senate.

D. Members of the Committee shall be reimbursed for their necessary travel expenses incurred in the performance of their duties in accordance with Section 456 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes from the legislative body in which they serve.

SECTION 2. NONCODIFICATION The provisions of Section 1 of this act shall not be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 1997.

SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
