An Act relating to motor vehicles; amending 47 O.S.  
1991, Section 6-121, which relates to extension of  
driver license during service in armed forces;  
adding spouses; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 1991, Section 6-121, is  
amended to read as follows:

Section 6-121. Any person or spouse of a person on active duty  
with the Armed Forces of the United States living outside the  
continental limits of the United States having a valid ~~driver's~~  
driver license issued by the State of Oklahoma for the operation of  
motor vehicles upon the highways of the state shall have, without  
additional charge, a valid ~~driver's~~ driver license for the duration  
of such service and for a period of sixty (60) days from and after  
~~his~~ the return of the person or spouse of the person to the  
continental limits of the United States from such service.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1998.
