An Act relating to motor vehicles; amending 47 O.S. 1991, Section 11-207, as last amended by Section 480, Chapter 133, O.S.L. 1997 (47 O.S. Supp. 1997, Section 11-207), which relates to interference with official traffic-control devices; adding 911 signs to official traffic-control devices which may not be interfered with; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 1991, Section 11-207, as last amended by Section 480, Chapter 133, O.S.L. 1997 (47 O.S. Supp. 1997, Section 11-207), is amended to read as follows:

Section 11-207. A. No person shall, without lawful authority, attempt to or in fact alter, deface, injure, knock down or remove any official traffic-control device, including any nine-one-one (911) emergency telephone service route markers, or any railroad sign or signal or any inscription, shield or insignia thereon, or any other part thereof.

B. If a violation of subsection A of this section results in personal injury to or death of any person, the person committing the violation shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a felony. The fine for a violation of this section shall be not more than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00).

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1998.
