An Act relating to game and fish; authorizing the Department of Wildlife Conservation to issue special permits for designated species; providing for special permits to be sold at public auction or by sealed bid; allowing the Department to contract for the public auctions; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3-103a of Title 29, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The Wildlife Conservation Commission may, by order, authorize the Department of Wildlife Conservation to issue, in addition to regular permits issued under this title, up to five (5) special permits each year for designated species. The special permits shall be sold at public auction or by sealed bid. The Department may contract with nonprofit organizations or charitable causes to conduct the public auctions.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1998.
