An Act relating to prisons and reformatories;
authorizing Department of Corrections to reimburse
certain employees for cost of commercial driver
license; providing for reimbursement of Department
by employee under certain circumstances; providing
for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 528.4 of Title 57, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The Department of Corrections is authorized to reimburse an
employee of the Department of Corrections for any cost associated
with initially obtaining or renewing a commercial driver license, if
a commercial driver license is necessary for that employee's
performance of official duties for the Department of Corrections.

B. Any employee who has received reimbursement pursuant to
subsection A of this section may be required to reimburse the
Department of Corrections a prorated amount of the cost of the
commercial driver license upon leaving the employment of the
Department of Corrections.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1998.
