An Act relating to chief executive offices; making an appropriation to the Office of the Governor; stating purpose; making an appropriation to the Office of the Lieutenant Governor; stating purpose; making appropriations nonfiscal; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of the Governor from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1999, the sum of Sixty-seven Thousand Eight Hundred Eleven Dollars (\$67,811.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Office of the Governor by law.

OFFICE OF THE LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of the Lieutenant Governor from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1999, the sum of Fifteen Thousand Six Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$15,650.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Office of the Lieutenant Governor by law.

SECTION 3. The appropriations made by this act shall not be subject to fiscal year limitations and shall be available for encumbrance and expenditure purposes for a period of thirty (30) months from the date this act is approved.

SECTION 4. This act shall become effective September 1, 1998.
