A Concurrent Resolution proclaiming April 9, 1997, to be Arts and Humanities Day in Oklahoma; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, the arts and humanities enhance and enrich the lives of all Oklahomans; and

WHEREAS, the arts and humanities provide essential vehicles to all Oklahomans for self expression; and

WHEREAS, the arts and humanities are a major element in the education of Oklahoma children, playing a vital role in bringing students together, promoting teamwork, and offering an opportunity to develop and enhance creativity, self-worth and imagination; and

WHEREAS, an alliance of over sixty Oklahoma cultural entities, including state agencies, and organizations and individuals representing arts, humanities or cultural constituencies from across the state have formed the Oklahoma Cultural Coalition to make their services and programs available to all communities in Oklahoma and are dedicated to generating support and ensuring the future of arts, humanities and other cultural programming throughout the state; and

WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Cultural Coalition is supporting activities at the State Capitol on April 9, 1997, including the performances and demonstrations by Master artisans, and discussions from arts and humanities organization leaders and education professionals about the abundance of and need for arts and cultural activities and opportunities available to all Oklahomans.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 46TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT Wednesday, April 9, 1997, is hereby proclaimed as Arts and Humanities Day in the State of Oklahoma.

THAT a copy of this resolution shall be sent to the Oklahoma Arts Council.
