A Concurrent Resolution relating to rules of the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department; waiving the thirty-legislative-day review period for proposed amendments to permanent rules OAC 725:15-21-2, OAC 725:15-21-3, OAC 725:15-21-4, OAC 725:15-21-5, OAC 725:15-21-6 and OAC 725:15-21-7 relating to the Oklahoma Recreational Trails Fund Program; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 308 of Title 75 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the Legislature may waive the thirty-legislative-day review period for any rule which has been transmitted for legislative review; and

WHEREAS, on April 18, 1997, the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department submitted proposed amendments to permanent rules OAC 725:15-21-2, OAC 725:15-21-3, OAC 725:15-21-4, OAC 725:15-21-5, OAC 725:15-21-6 and OAC 725:15-21-7 relating to the Oklahoma Recreational Trails Fund Program regarding eligibility; reimbursement procedures; limitations on grant awards; procedures for submission and review of project applications; acquisition policies and procedures; and construction policies and procedures to the Legislature for its review; and

WHEREAS, the Legislature recognizes the substantive value and importance of such rules.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 46TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the Legislature hereby waives the thirty-legislative-day review period of the proposed amendments to permanent rules OAC 725:15-21-2, OAC 725:15-21-3, OAC 725:15-21-4, OAC 725:15-21-5, OAC 725:15-21-6 and OAC 725:15-21-7 relating to the Oklahoma Recreational Trails Fund Program of the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department.

THAT copies of this resolution shall be distributed to the Governor, the Executive Director of the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department and the Editor of "The Oklahoma Register".
