A Joint Resolution designating a portion of State Highway 47 and 47A as the "Black Kettle Memorial Highway"; requiring Oklahoma Department of Transportation to place permanent markers; and directing distribution.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 46TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

SECTION 1. State Highway 47 from the Oklahoma-Texas state line to the City of Cheyenne and State Highway 47A shall be designated the "Black Kettle Memorial Highway" as a lasting tribute to the great Cheyenne Chief. The Oklahoma Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed upon the highway bearing the name.

SECTION 2. A copy of this resolution shall be distributed to the Secretary of Transportation.
