A Resolution commending, thanking and congratulating certain individuals; expressing appreciation to Margaret M. Coe; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, in an effort to bring order and accessibility to rulemaking in Oklahoma, the Legislature enacted legislation in 1987 that required the publication of an administrative code; and

WHEREAS, the Secretary of State has announced that the Oklahoma Administrative Code (Code), which contains 19,000 pages in 19 bound volumes, is now available; and

WHEREAS, Margaret (Peggy) M. Coe, the Managing Editor of the Oklahoma Administrative Code, has worked on the massive undertaking of the Code project from its inception; and

WHEREAS, Peggy's tireless efforts and extraordinary level of commitment has resulted in the outstanding accomplishment of providing Oklahomans, for the first time, a uniform compilation of administrative rules of state agencies in a single comprehensive format comparable to the Oklahoma Statutes or the Code of Federal Regulations. As such, its reliability and usefulness to persons and businesses regulated by the rules will be unprecedented; and

WHEREAS, Peggy's dedication to duty, unyielding devotion and industrious hard work exemplifies a role model all state employees can follow.
