RESOLUTION NO. 1 By: Long

A Resolution requesting the Oklahoma Department of Transportation to reopen 101st South at US 75 in Tulsa County; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Department of Transportation has closed 101st South at US 75 in Tulsa County; and

WHEREAS, the closing of such road limits access to homes and property by area residents; and

WHEREAS, the closing of such road is further complicated when Polecat Creek floods, insofar as such flooding often closes 33rd West Avenue, thus trapping area residents from fleeing to higher ground; and

WHEREAS, ingress and egress to personal property should not be unfairly compromised by the Oklahoma Department of Transportation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 46TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

THAT the Oklahoma Department of Transportation reopen 101st South at US 75 in Tulsa County and reengineer the intersection if necessary to effectuate same.

THAT copies of this resolution be distributed to Neal McCaleb, Cabinet Secretary of Transportation and Director of the Oklahoma Department of Transportation and to the Governor of our Great State.
