A Resolution honoring the memory of the late Perry Anderson; praising his work with senior citizens; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, Perry Anderson served as Director of Aging for the Southern Oklahoma Development Association (SODA) from September 1, 1986 - January 31, 1997, and dedicated his life to church, family, the youth of his community and, most especially, to senior citizens; and

WHEREAS, Perry Anderson served as a church leader, civic executive, devoted husband and father, mentor to his colleagues, a booster of education, a beacon to youth, high school basketball referee and an advocate for the under-privileged. Above all, Perry Anderson was a loyal employee of the Area Agency on Aging, dedicated to senior citizen's issues; and

WHEREAS, Perry Anderson died earlier this year in a tragic car accident February 1, 1997. Perry Anderson will be remembered for his contributions to the elderly and selfless devotion to the causes of senior citizens.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 46TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

THAT the Oklahoma State Senate honors the memory of the late Perry Anderson.

THAT the Oklahoma State Senate praises the work of Perry Anderson with senior citizens.
