A Resolution congratulating and commending the El Reno High School boys' wrestling team; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, the Lloyd Noble Center in Norman, Oklahoma, hosted the state Class 4A wrestling championship tournament, which was handily won by the El Reno Indians high school boys' wrestling team; and

WHEREAS, Archie Randall has been coach at El Reno High School for the past four years, during which the Indians have finished in succession sixth, fifth, first and, again, first; and also won the last two Dual State titles; and

WHEREAS, El Reno Indians finalists included sophomore Tyrone Lewis at 130 pounds and junior Jerrod Sanders at 135 pounds. Individual titlists included junior Chad Whitney at 119 pounds and with a 36-1 season record; senior Richy Daughtry; senior Joe Blackwolf, who won two upset victories over previous title holders; senior Ben Iker with a 36-1 season record; and senior Nathan James with a 36-1 season record; and

WHEREAS, in the Class 4A tournament, El Reno won the team title with 167 points, a total state tournament officials believed to be the highest point total of all time. El Reno had seven finalists and won five individual titles.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 46TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

THAT the Oklahoma State Senate congratulates the El Reno High School boys' wrestling team for winning the Class 4A wrestling title.

THAT the Oklahoma State Senate commends the El Reno High School boys' wrestling team for winning two consecutive Class 4A wrestling titles and their last two Dual State titles.
