RESOLUTION NO. 44 By: Stipe

A Resolution relating to professions and occupations;
encouraging the Board of Podiatric Medical Examiners to
consider certain hiring; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, the Board of Podiatric Medical Examiners presently
contracts with the State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision
for administrative services; and

WHEREAS, the executive director of the State Board of Medical
Licensure and Supervision functions as the staff person responsible
for providing the contracted services; and

WHEREAS, the hiring of the executive director of the State Board
of Medical Licensure and Supervision as executive director of the
Board of Podiatric Medical Examiners by the Board of Podiatric
Medical Examiners will eliminate redundancy and provide a more
consistent method of administration of the office of the Board of
Podiatric Medical Examiners.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 1ST SESSION
OF THE 46TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

THAT the Senate hereby encourages the Board of Podiatric Medical
Examiners to consider hiring as executive director of the agency the
executive director of the State Board of Medical Licensure and
Supervision.

Podiatric Medical Examiners and the State Board of Medical Licensure
and Supervision.
