RESOLUTION NO. 81 By: Dickerson

A Resolution praising the athletic accomplishments of the Cameron Yellowjackets; congratulating them for winning the state championship; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, the Cameron Yellowjackets, for the sixth straight time, won the State Class A spring baseball title by defeating Rattan 4-3 in the championship finals held at Eastern State College at Wilburton; and

WHEREAS, Cameron, with a 34-4 record this spring, has made 22 consecutive appearances in the state tournament, including both spring and fall baseball seasons; and

WHEREAS, this is the tenth state title in baseball for Cameron, seven of them won by Coach John Long. The sixth straight title breaks a state record held by Asher for its five straight championships.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 46TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:
