An Act relating to roads, bridges and ferries;
creating the Oklahoma Trucking Advisory Board;
providing for membership; specifying powers and
duties; providing for codification; and providing
an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 301.1 of Title 69, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. There is hereby created the Oklahoma Trucking Advisory
Board. The Board shall consist of the following members:

1. The Director of the Department of Transportation or
designee;
2. The Chair of the Oklahoma Turnpike Authority or designee;
3. The Commissioner of the Department of Public Safety or
designee;
4. The Chair of the Corporation Commission or designee;
5. The Director of a statewide trucking association or
designee;
6. The Chair of the Oklahoma Tax Commission or designee;
7. The President Pro Tempore of the Senate or designee;
8. The Speaker of the House of Representatives or designee; and
9. Four representatives selected by a statewide trucking
association subject to the approval of a majority of the members of
the Board.

B. Each member shall hold office for a two-year term or until
the successor of the member takes office. The term of office shall
begin on July 1 of the succeeding fiscal year. The Board shall
select a chair from among the members of the Board each year. It
shall be the duty of the Board to act in an advisory capacity to the
Director of the Department of Transportation. The Board shall meet
no less than on a quarterly basis with the Director of the
Department of Transportation and the staff of the Director to
discuss areas of mutual concern.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1997.
