An Act relating to the United States; ceding  
concurrent jurisdiction over certain real property  
to the United States; reserving concurrent  
jurisdiction for certain purposes; providing for  
the termination of such jurisdiction; providing for  
codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 4.2 of Title 80, unless there is  
created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Notwithstanding any other provision of law, concurrent  
jurisdiction is hereby ceded to the United States over the tract of  
land comprised and any tracts of land hereafter comprised within the  
limits of the Oklahoma City Federal Transfer Center, a facility  
which is leased to the United States and located at the Will Rogers  
World Airport in Oklahoma City, County of Oklahoma. The State of  
Oklahoma reserves concurrent jurisdiction to enforce the criminal  
and civil laws of this state within the correctional facility. The  
jurisdiction so ceded shall continue no longer than the United  
States shall lease or own such lands or portions thereof.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
