AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to Soldiers and sailors; requiring certain Veteran Centers to remain open, operational, maintained, and funded in the event of certain federal budget reductions or cuts; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 63.8A of Title 72, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The following Veterans Centers shall remain open and fully operational and maintained by state funds and any other funds available to these centers in the event that the federal budget terminates or reduces federal funding to these centers:

1. The Ardmore Division located in Ardmore, Oklahoma;
2. The Claremore Division located in Claremore, Oklahoma;
3. The Clinton Division located in Clinton, Oklahoma;
4. The Norman Division located in Norman, Oklahoma;
5. The Sulphur Division located in Sulphur, Oklahoma;

6. The Talihina Division located in Talihina, Oklahoma; and

7. The George Nigh Rehabilitation Institute located in
Okmulgee, Oklahoma.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective October 1, 1997.
