AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to Sunset; amending 74 O.S. 1991, Section 3902, as amended by Section 2, Chapter 31, O.S.L. 1995 (74 O.S. Supp. 1996, Section 3902), which relates to the Oklahoma Sunset Law; clarifying language; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 1991, Section 3902, as amended by Section 2, Chapter 31, O.S.L. 1995 (74 O.S. Supp. 1996, Section 3902), is amended to read as follows:

Section 3902. As used in the Oklahoma Sunset Law:

1. "Statutory entity" ~~means~~ shall mean any department, agency, commission, board or other regulatory instrumentality of state government enumerated in the Oklahoma Sunset Law; and

2. "Termination date" ~~means~~ shall mean the date provided for termination of legislative authority for the existence of a particular entity as provided for in this act.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby

declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
