AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to tourism; amending 74 O.S. 1991, Section 1803, which relates to the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Commission and Department; and clarifying language.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 1991, Section 1803, is amended to read as follows:

Section 1803. It shall be the purpose of the Commission and the Department to ~~promote~~:

1. Promote the development and use of the state's lodges, parks and recreational areas;

~~promote~~ 2. Promote tourism by publicity and dissemination of information;

~~assist~~ 3. Assist in promotion of events sponsored by municipalities, associations and organizations commemorating special events of local or historical interest; and

~~function~~ 4. Function in an advisory capacity to the Governor, State Legislature, state agencies, municipalities, and to private organizations on matters pertaining to tourism and recreation.
