AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to workers' compensation; amending Section 14, Chapter 1, 2nd Extraordinary Session, O.S.L. 1994 (85 O.S. Supp. 1996, Section 61.2), which relates to the Workers' Compensation Act; clarifying language; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 14, Chapter 1, 2nd Extraordinary Session, O.S.L. 1994 (85 O.S. Supp. 1996, Section 61.2), is amended to read as follows:

Section 61.2 All self-insured employers and group self-insurance association plans shall be required to develop and implement workplace safety plans by January 1, 1996, and shall notify the Administrator of the Workers' Compensation Court, in writing, upon implementation of the plan. All private employers who become self-insured after ~~the effective date of this act~~ November 4, 1994, and group self-insurance association plans approved by the Administrator of the Workers' Compensation Court after ~~the effective date of this act~~ November 4, 1994, shall implement a workplace safety plan within six (6) months of becoming self-insured and shall

notify the Administrator of the Workers' Compensation Court, in writing, upon implementation of the plan.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1997.
