AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Oklahoma Public Employees

Retirement System; amending 74 O.S. 1991, Section
901, which relates to purposes; modifying
reference; providing an effective date; and
declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 1991, Section 901, is
amended to read as follows:

Section 901. The purpose of this act is to provide an orderly
means whereby employees of the participating employers who qualify
by reason of age, or condition, and service, as herein set forth,
may be transferred to inactive service without prejudice and without
inflicting undue hardship upon the employees transferred, and to
enable such employees to accumulate deferred income reserves for
themselves and their dependents to provide for old age, death, and
inactive service, and for the purpose of effecting economy and
efficiency in the administration of ~~governmental affairs~~ government.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1997.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby

declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
