AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to crimes and punishments; amending
21 O.S. 1991, Section 1592, which relates to
uttering a forged instrument; clarifying language;
and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 1991, Section 1592, is
amended to read as follows:

Section 1592. Every person who, with intent to defraud, utters
or publishes as true any forged, altered or counterfeited instrument
or any counterfeit gold or silver coin, the forging, altering or
counterfeiting of which is hereinbefore declared to be punishable,
knowing ~~such~~ the instrument or coin ~~to be~~ is forged, altered or
counterfeited, is guilty of forgery in the second degree.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1997.
