AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to criminal procedure; amending 22 O.S. 1991, Section 16, which relates to jury trials; clarifying language; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 22 O.S. 1991, Section 16, is amended to read as follows:

Section 16. No person can be convicted of a public offense, unless by the verdict of a jury, accepted and recorded by the court, or upon a plea of guilty, or upon final judgment for or against ~~him~~ that person upon a demurrer to the indictment, or upon a judgment of a police or justice's court in cases in which such judgment may be lawfully given without the intervention of a jury or grand jury.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1997.
