AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to marriage and family; creating the Oklahoma Family Law Code; specifying contents; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 100 of Title 43, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Oklahoma Family Law Code".

B. The Oklahoma Family Law Code shall consist of:

Chapter 1: Dissolution, Legal Separation, and Annulment

Chapter 2: Child Custody and Visitation

Chapter 3: Equitable Division of Property

Chapter 4: Maintenance and Child Support

Chapter 5: Enforcement

Chapter 6: Paternity

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1997.
